What is Authority Control?

- Consistent use and maintenance of names, subjects, series, and uniform titles whenever they are used as a heading in a bibliographic record

Authority Records



Harold Evans



Harold Evans, the author of *The American Century* and now *They Made America*, is a celebrated historian and journalist. He was the editor of the *Sunday Times of London* for fourteen years and then the *Times of London* before settling in 1984 in America, where he has

been successively founding editor of *CondéNast Traveler*; president and publisher of Random House; editorial director and vice chairman of *U.S. News & World Report*, *the Atlantic magazine*, *Fast Company*, and the *New York Daily News*. In 2002 Britain's journalists voted Evans the greatest all-time British newspaper editor. He was knighted in Queen Elizabeth's 2004 New Year honors list. He lives in New York with his wife, Tina Brown, and their two children.






Richard French

Richard French holds a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of British Columbia and a D. Phil. from the Oxford University in Modern History. He has taught in the Department of History at Princeton University (1971-72) and the Faculty of Management of McGill University (1977-1981).

He was a member of the Machinery of Government section of the Privy Council Office, the secretariat to the cabinet of the Government of Canada, from 1974 to 1977. Elected to the National Assembly of Quebec for the constituency of Westmount in 1981 and re-elected in 1985, he held, among other responsibilities, that of Minister of Communications of Quebec from 1985 to 1988. He resigned from the Quebec cabinet in 1988 when the government of which he was a member refused to respect the findings of the Supreme Court of Canada that certain aspects of Quebec's language legislation were ultra vires both Quebec and Canadian human rights legislation. He was not a candidate in the provincial election of 1989.

From 1989 to 1999, he was a senior officer of Bell Canada, including more than three years as the founding CEO of Tata Communications, a mobile telephony joint venture in the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. He lived, studied and worked in London and Berlin from 1999 to 2005, when he became Vice Chairman, Telecommunications, of the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission, the CRTC, from which he resigned in June 2007.

The x55 tagged authority records are also indexed in the LCSH index. An example of a newly added Genre authority record is sh2007025004 (ARN 7519072), Fiction films.

Although the Genre index labels are not present in the authority searching or browsing dropdown lists in Client 1.7x, the genre indexes can be accessed via the command line. The index label for the genre index is 'ge'. An example of a search from the command line is: ge: films ; and an example of a browse is sca ge: films.

Please note: At this time, SACO participants still have to wait to propose new headings.

Currently, headings tagged as 655, second indicator 0 are **not** candidates for controlling. Changes to enable the controlling of genre headings will be part of a future Connexion enhancement.

The Library of Congress recently announced a change in policy about adding death dates to personal name heading and a revision to the LCRI for AACR2 rule 22.17 that allows the option for catalogers to add death dates to personal name headings with open dates (http://www.loc.gov/catdir/cpso/lcri22_17imp.html).

Both the Library of Congress and OCLC are aware that many libraries will be very interested in incorporating these changes into their catalogs. Libraries that use authority control services for ongoing processing will receive these changes as part of their normal workflows but, for other libraries, OCLC is providing this service to announce headings to which death dates have been added.
