Library day, Oct. 21, 1904.

All librarians and teachers are urged to make Library day a special occasion. Teachers should use it to draw their pupils closer to the world of books, and librarians should use it to draw teachers, pupils and patrons to the library. A few suggestions for the observance of the day were printed in the Nebraska Teacher for October. Let librarians co-operate with teachers in following out those suggestions. It is further suggested that a series of Columbus tableaux could be given for the children very effectively at the children's rooms in the libraries.

County superintendents can help to make this day count for the educational advancement of their charges by urging the observance of Library day.

Librarians can use the day to attract visitors to the library and acquaint patrons with the resources and needs of the library. It is a good time to ask for gifts of material on the discovery of America.
