To librarians of Nebraska libraries:-

The law creating this Commission makes the collection of statistics and information concerning the libraries of this state obligatory. You will greatly assist us in the preparation of our biennial report if you will fill out the enclosed blank and return it to us immediately. If you will consult our first biennial report, a copy of which was sent you immediately after its publication, you will be able to make your report so that it will not overlap the previous one. Also, if you know of any libraries not there reported, we would like to know of them and have the names of the librarians or trustees. There are a good many libraries in Nebraska that we have no record of, and you can help us to make a good showing by supplying information of such libraries.

At some subsequent time it is our intention to print a pamphlet descriptive of Nebraska libraries and the buildings that house them. If you have not already filed in our office a history of your library, together with photographs of your building, both interior and exterior views, we would regard it as a favor if you would do so now.

We invite you to make use of this Commission in any way that will benefit your library and the public which you serve.
