FIELD DEFINITION AND SCOPE

Fields 800-830 contain series added entries for series associated with a title. These fields are used to trace a series added entry when the form of series present in the 490 Series Statement field cannot serve additionally as a series added entry. An 8XX series added entry field is not used in conjunction with the 440 field, which functions both as a series statement and as a series added entry.

A description of the first indicator and all subfield codes, as well as input conventions for the 800, 810, 811, and 830 fields, are given in the following General Information sections: [800](#), [810](#), [811](#), and [830](#). The second indicator is described in the specific sections for each field.

CONTENT DESIGNATOR HISTORY

Field 800 - Series Added Entry - Title (C510,C511, C512)
 Field 810 was made obsolete when the format was made to use field 810 for both uniform titles and conventional titles that are not named under a name. The field 810, the first indicator was abolished, the second was defined for meeting characters (values 5-9). The subfield codes were 1a (Title), 1b (Edition), 1c (Volume or number).


