

## Language Note Field

The MARC field 546 is used for information relating to the language of the items being cataloged. It is used if there is language information that isn't apparent from the rest of the record.

For example, if a book contained text in both English and Spanish, that information could be included in a 546 field.

546 \_\_ \$a Text in English and Spanish.

Notice that both indicators for this field are undefined, and that the note goes in subfield a.

The 546 field is also used for closed captioning information for video items.

546 \_\_ \$a Closed captioned.

It can also be used to indicate that a video item has subtitles.

546 \_\_ \$a Subtitles in English, French and Spanish.
