

JAWS Version 14 Installation

Please read the bulleted items below before installing Kurzweil 1000 version 14:

- Version 12 of JAWS must be uninstalled before you can install version 14 of JAWS.
 - JAWS software is designed for people with low or no vision. The software will speak to you as it is being installed. It is important that you have the audio turned on and that you listen to the installation instructions as you install the JAWS software.
1. Log on to the ADA computer using an administrator user account. The Staff user account that was included on your original ADA computer is an administrative user account.
 2. Disable the security software on the computer.
 3. Uninstall JAWS version 12 only, do not uninstall the shared components.
 - a. Open the Start menu from the Windows taskbar.
 - b. Go to the All Programs menu and select JAWS 12.0.
 - c. From the JAWS 12.0 submenu, select the Tools folder.
 - d. From the Tools folder select Uninstall JAWS 12.0.
 - e. “Do you want to allow the following program to update software on this computer?”
Click Yes.
 - f. Make sure “Uninstall JAWS only” is selected. Click Next.
 - g. Remove JAWS 12.0 – Click Remove.
 - h. Respond “Yes” to prompt to Remove all settings for JAWS.
 - i. Click on the “FINISH” button and the computer should respond with “Uninstallation is Complete”. Click OK.
 - j. Restart the computer and Log On to the Staff account.
 4. Logged on to the Staff account access the following web site,
 - a. <http://www.freedomscientific.com/downloads/jaws/JAWS-whats-new.asp>
 - b. Click on “JAWS download links” or scroll down to Download JAWS 14 and click on the following link, JAWS 14.0.1037 64-bit – December 2012 English (123 MB) (Note: The name of the file may be slightly different depending on when you access the file download link. Just be sure to select the file link that includes the number **14** and **64-bit** in the file name.)
 5. Download and Run the installation program.
 - a. “Do you want to allow the following program to update software on this computer?”
Click Yes.
 6. Restart the computer and log on to Staff account.
 7. Allow the JAWS software to continue the installation process.
 8. Open JAWS and run the Setup Wizard.
 9. Select to run the Typical setup.
 10. Accept the default “Speech Settings”.
 11. Run JAWS Settings – Uncheck “Start JAWS at the Logon Screen” and select Never “Start JAWS after logon for this user:”
 12. “Initial state of NumLock key” leave set to default “Turn off at startup”.
 13. Verbosity Settings – accept the defaults

14. Braille Settings – accept the defaults
15. Complete the installation process.
16. To complete the registration and authorization for JAWS version 14 you will need to select “Register now online “ when prompted by the program to activate the JAWS program.
 - a. Complete product registration online and click on the “submit” button.
 - b. A message will appear on your computer screen, “Congratulations JAWS version 14 is installed.”
 - c. A message will appear on the screen instructing you to restart the computer to complete the activation of JAWS 14. Restart your computer at this time.
17. Check for updates that need to be installed for JAWS 14.
 - a. Open the JAWS software, click Help and select “Check For Updates...”
 - b. A message will appear, “Do you want to allow the following program to update software on this computer?” Click Yes.
 - c. Select all of the items to be updated. Click Install. Depending on the number of items and your internet speed this may take quite a bit of time.
 - d. Reboot the computer and log on as a patron.
 - e. Verify that JAWS opens properly on both the Patron and Staff user accounts on the ADA Workstation. With JAWS running open a website. JAWS should start reading the information. To stop it from reading press the ctrl key on the keyboard.
18. You have successfully completed the installation, registration and activation and installed the updates for JAWS 14.
19. The final step on your ADA workstation is to enable the security software on the computer.
